Internships Update...Students Excited for the Next Opportunity

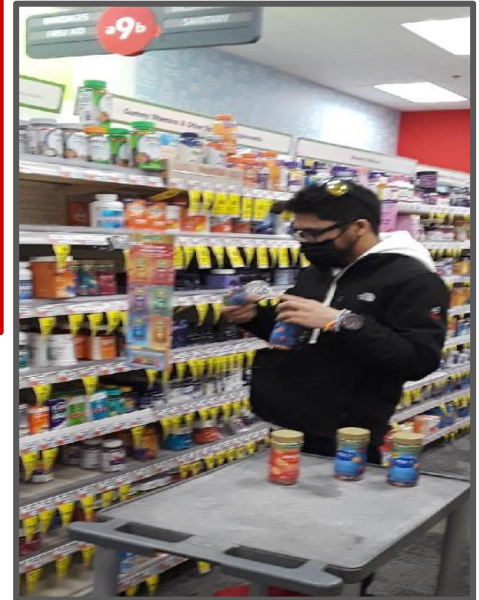
