Positive Behavior Intervention Strategies (PBIS)

Your student earns "Caught Ya's" every day for all the big & little things they do that are worthy of positive praise and support. Examples of students caught being good are:

- o saying "please" & "thank you"
- helping a friend out
- helping their teacher
- listening
- following directions

How can you help as a parent or guardian?





- remind them each morning to get as many 'caught ya's' as they can!
- ask them when they come home how many "caught ya's" they earned
- continue to praise them for the good work they are doing each day!
- lessen their sugar intake with food sent from home and before they come to school
